Suffolk County is proposing to utilize increased state aid towards service improvements to the Suffolk County Transit bus system. Specifically, the County is proposing to increase AM and PM peak service and add additional evening runs on the S66 bus route, establish a new route between Babylon LIRR and Farmingdale State College which will travel along NYS 109, and begin a pilot ridesharing service in the eastern part of the Town of Southampton. Your feedback on these proposals, and other desired service improvements, is welcome at these hearings.
